


Acrylic Paint on Paper, Photoshop


The subject openly contrasts the title of the single: no boat, no water. A remote sense of the water is merely present in the reflection of the type. This was created to instigate curiosity in the observer.












Paper.

Acrylic paint, sand and glue on paper: it lays out the basis for the CD cover.






A more amusing "horse expression" which will liven up the painting



Photoshop, Acrylic Paint, sand and glue on Paper With a new face and a little more lighting, the painting is ready to meet the type.






